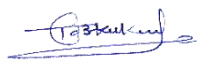

Date:- 02/10/2024

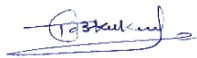
Venue:- Dnyandeep college Morvande-Boraj

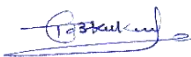

Dnyandeep College of Science and Commerce and WDC has organized Girls Counselling Program for this program the main topics are:

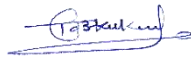
1. Give information regarding to the WDC (for first year students)
